Teaching Vocabulary

Students with larger vocabularies are more successful in school. Students who read often naturally improve their vocabulary. Nagy says that 25 to 50 percent of vocabulary growth is attained through incidental learning while reading (Nagy et al. 1987). Check out this statistic:

This chart compares students ranking on standardized tests with the number of minutes they read each day and the number of words they are exposed to while reading. Simply stated, if the students read more, they learn more words and succeed on standardized tests.

It is clear from these statistics when students read, they are more successful. Along with building in reading time for students, teachers must teach vocabulary directly.

Unfortunately, simply looking up words in the dictionary is not teaching vocabulary. Students need intensive vocabulary instruction and multiple exposures to a word over time. Try this simple, but effective strategy called Word Wizard.

Teacher Prep

- Pre-read a text and select 3 words important to student learning.
- Write one word in each Word box at the top of the matrix.
- Write the sentence where you found each word in the box below the word.
- Duplicate the Word Wizard matrix for each student and make a transparency for you to use.

Getting Started

- We suggest that you carefully model the first word and use a Think Aloud.
- Read the first word and read the word in context
- Show students how you would use a thesaurus to find synonyms. The synonyms should be words with which students are familiar. www.dictionary.com is a great on-line tool.

Instructions To Your Students

- Use the context and your synonyms to write what you think the word means in the next box.
- Now, find the word in the dictionary and write the definition. Make sure the definition corresponds to the way the word is used.
- Next draw a picture that represents the word.
- Write a key word or phrase that will jog your memory and cue you to the word's meaning. For example, if your word is 'dilemma' your memory clue could be 'two lemons'. Di- means two, and a dilemma is two difficult, or sour, choices.

Variation

• Allow the students to do the next word in pairs.
